



BIANNUAL SCHOOLS REPORT

JULY 2021

Every six months, the NAMACB sends NAMA recognized schools' biannual updates about NAMACB activities and data on the graduates sent to take the NAMACB exams. Enclosed is national data on the exams and data on how your graduates are faring. For some schools the data set is still small. For these schools we are not including individual pass/fail rates.

This is our sixth biannual report, which includes AHC Live Exam and AP Live Exam data. We hope this report will encourage you to promote the board certification exam more with your students.

Aside from exam data, we also provide an update on NAMACB activities. Below are the NAMACB's accomplishments for 2021, and what is planned for the second half of 2021:

In the first half of 2021, the NAMACB continued to overcome challenges due to COVID and made significant strides in exam registration.

- Kryterion continued to make online proctoring easier for examinees due to COVID (i.e., they may take the exam online with more lenient webcam requirements.)
- Extended the 20% discount on the AHC and AP exam registration fee through June 30, 2021.
- The AD Beta Exam Review subcommittee worked on developing criteria on who will be eligible to sit for the AD Beta exam, as well as developed an application and review process for applicants.
- AD Beta exam is scheduled to launch in the second half of 2021.
- The NAMACB held a board meeting with the directors of NAMA recognized schools to collaborate with schools on the board certification exams. At the meeting it was announced that qualified school faculty would be eligible for a 75% discount to take the board certification exams to help prep their students.
- In June, 47 AHC and AP students and graduates applied to take the board certification exams. Of those, 19 applicants graduated from Boston Ayurveda School who will be making the board certification exam their final exam.

For the remainder of 2021, the NAMACB plans to:

- Finalize the AD exam and completion of the AD Beta exam application process
- Complete the study guides and reference guides for the AD exam
- Further develop the NAMACB Ethics and Disciplinary Review Panel, which will evaluate complaints against NAMACB-board certified Ayurvedic professionals and will take disciplinary action when required.
Launch official communications on board certification exams with NAMA Student Members and recognized schools.

NATIONAL AHC LIVE EXAM DATA

- Seventy-eight (78) AHC exams have been taken through June 2021. The exam was launched in May 2017 (78 exams over 3 years, 7 months for an average of 22 exams per year).
- The passing score for the AHC exam is 67 points.
- The pass rate for the 78 examinees is 76% (59 have passed, 19 have not).
- When a school has over five examinees, we will send the school data on how its students did in each of the five exam topics.

NATIONAL AP LIVE EXAM DATA

- There have been forty-three (43) AP exams taken through June 2021. The exam was launched in September 2018 (43 exams over 33 months). The exam went live in September 2018 and the first exam was taken in April 2019.
- The passing score for AP exams is 47 points.
- The pass rate for the 43 examinees is 98%.
